PHILIPPINE VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY VISITORS FOR BUSINESS OR TOURISM

I. NO VISA ENTRY

Citizens of countries listed below may enter the Philippines without visas for a stay not exceeding twenty one (21) days, for tourism and business purposes, provided that: the nature of their visit is for tourism or business purposes; their passports are valid for six (6) months beyond the contemplated period of their stay; and they hold valid tickets for their journey to their port of origin or next port of destination.

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR BUSINESS OR TOURIST VISA

1. Duly accomplished Non-Immigrant Visa Form (F.A. Form No. 2-A) (All applications submitted by mail or courier service and through travel agencies or representatives must be duly notarized.) Original and photocopy of the data pages of passport (Passport should be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of a person's stay in the Philippines.)
2. One (1) 2" x 2" size photograph taken within the past six (6) months
3. Proof of financial capacity to travel:

Tourist:
 - a. Round-trip airline/cruise ticket; or
 - b. Certification from the travel agency that the applicant will be in possession of a round-trip airline/cruise ticket; and
 - c. Copy of checking or savings account or other proof of financial capacity
Business:
 - a. Round-trip airline/cruise ticket; or
 - b. Certification from the travel agency that the applicant will be in possession of a round-trip airline/cruise ticket; and
 - c. Letter from company/office requesting the issuance of a visa, guaranteeing financial support to the applicant and stating the nature and duration of the visit
4. For a minor traveling alone, or with the person other than his/her parent: affidavit of consent and support signed by at least one parent

N.B. Guardian of minor must submit requirements for ***Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG)*** upon arrival at the airport. For requirements see Philippine Bureau of Immigration website at www.immigration.gov.ph.

5. Fees:

Processing fees are non-refundable and payable in cash, when applying in person; or when applying by mail, in money order issued in the US, certified treasurer's, manager's or cashier's check issued by a bank in the U.S., or if applicant is outside the U.S., by a local bank that has a corresponding bank in the U.S., payable to the Embassy of the Republic of the Philippines. Personal checks and personal money order are not accepted.

For citizens of countries listed in no. 1 above:

- a. Single entry valid for three (3) months US\$30.00

- b. Multiple entry valid for six (6) months US\$60.00
- c. Multiple entry valid for twelve (12) month US\$90.00

For citizens of countries not listed above, please consult the Embassy.

6. If applying by mail or courier service or through representatives, the following additional requirements should be complied with:

- a. Application forms must be notarized.
- b. The fee should be in the form of a money order or certified, treasurer's, manager's or cashier's check as specified above.
- c. A self-addressed envelope and
- d.

For applicant from U.S. and U.S. Territories: One (1) U.S. Postal Service Express Mail Envelope with the corresponding U.S. postage stamps required to return the documents (Do not use P.O. Box mailing address and metered stamps.)

For applicant from Other Countries and territories within the Embassy's jurisdiction:

Certified, treasurer's, manager's or cashier's check issued by a local bank that has a corresponding bank in the U.S., payable to the courier of choice, such as FEDEX, DHL, UPS, etc. in **U.S. dollars**, in the amount required to return the documents. Avoid use of P.O. Box mailing address.

Instructions to charge to recipient, credit card account, or corporate/personal courier account are not accepted.

N.B. Add two (2) ounces to the weight of each document to be processed.

The Embassy of the Republic of the Philippines assumes no responsibility for any delay or loss in the mail, or while the documents are in the custody of the courier service. The applicant shall note the tracking numbers of all envelopes used and submitted.
